STELLENBOSCH LANDFILL – SHAPING OF CELLS 1 & 2

The STELLENBOSCH Municipality invites tenders for the complete SHAPING OF THE EXISTING CELLS 1 & 2 at the Stellenbosch Landfill.

Bidders must be registered with the CIDB in a CE class of construction work and have a grading designation equal to or higher than that determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with regulation 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, 2008. **It is estimated that tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of 6CE or higher.**

A compulsory briefing meeting will be held on Wednesday, 10 December 2014 at 11h00 at the Stellenbosch Landfill entrance, Devon valley Road (330 56' 21.81" S, 180 49' 15.89" E), Stellenbosch.

Documents with specifications are obtainable, from 28 November 2014, during office hours, from The Supply Chain Management Unit, Stellenbosch Municipality, 1st Floor, Room no.121, Plein Street, Stellenbosch. A non-refundable deposit of R250.00 payable to the Stellenbosch Municipality is required on collection of the documents.

Sealed bids with the Bidder's name and address and the endorsement "**TENDER No B/SM 58/15: STELLENBOSCH LANDFILL – SHAPING OF CELLS 1 & 2**" on the envelope, must be placed in the bid box situated at the Stellenbosch Municipality, Plein Street, Stellenbosch or posted to The Stellenbosch Municipality, PO Box 17, Stellenbosch, 7599 to reach us not later than **23 January 2015 at 12h00** after which the bids will be opened in public.

The bid box is accessible 24 hours a day and bids must be accompanied by the complete set of documents. Bids not accompanied by the complete bid document, will not be considered. Late, electronic format or faxed bids will not be considered and the Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest, part of or any bid.

Functionality will be evaluated as an eligibility criterion. The eligibility criteria relate to the bidder's ability to provide a quality service to the Municipality. The bidder's experience etc will be evaluated. Bidders scoring less than the required minimum will not meet the eligibility criteria and will therefore not be considered for further evaluation.

Bids attaining a score equal or higher than the minimum required will be evaluated in accordance with the Supply Chain Management Policy of the Stellenbosch Municipality and the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011. The 90/10 points system will be applicable.
