**1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

Council to take note of the National Road Traffic Fine List.

**2. BACKGROUND**

The National Road Traffic Act fine list has been revised for the Western Cape Province. Approval by magistrates were 01 July 2014 and implementation by 01 August 2014.

**3. DISCUSSION**

On 7 August 2014, Stellenbosch Municipality did a media release on the implementation of the new fine list. Motorists were cautioned about the new Traffic Offence Code Book listing new rates or fines for traffic offences. The code that was published by the Western Cape Provincial Government was implemented on 1 August 2014 throughout the entire Western Cape.

The Traffic Department welcomed the new code that would assist with its zero tolerance initiative. It is hoped that the new rates will deter road users from committing traffic offences. The Municipality

launched its ongoing stop-at-the stop street campaign in 2012 where the fine amounts to R1500.00 for general motorists and R2000.00 for taxi drivers (taxis).

Exceeding speed limit 60km/h (if driving between 71-74km/h) – R 200.00  
Disobey Stop Sign (Motor-vehicle) – R1500.00  
Disobey Stop Sign (with PrDP) (Motor-vehicle) – R2000.00  
Park on sidewalk (pavement) – R500.00  
Disobey No-stopping sign – R500.00  
Disobey red-line – R500.00  
Disobey disabled parking bay – R800.00  
Disobey loading zone – R800.00  
Disobey no-parking – R500.00  
Disobey red robot – R2000.00  
Disobey red robot (with PrDP) – R2000.00  
Drive without driver's license – R1000  
(Not in vehicle – R500.00)  
Driver's License card expired – R500.00  
Cellphone – R1000.00  
Safety Belt – R500.00  
Driver fail to ensure passenger under age of 14 yrs to wear seatbelt – R1000.00  
Obstruction – R1000.00  
Park in front of private entrance – R500.00  
Disregard railway crossing – R3000.00  
Disregard scholar stop – R3000.00  
Disobey stop sign (pedal cycle) – R500.00  
Learner driver whilst not accompanied by licensed driver – R700.00  
Wheel spinning – R1500.00  
Inconsiderate driving – R2500.00
