This year is of course an election year for the country and the national and provincial elections are expected to take during May. The last registration weekend took place in January. Voters however still have an opportunity to register at the nearest Independent Electoral Commission office until the voters roll is closed. It is expected that the date of the election will be announced during the President's State of the Nation Address. Once the President has announced the dates, the IEC will announce when the voters roll will close. When the voters roll closes, new registrations will not be allowed until after the election. Please make sure that you are registered to vote. You can check your registration status by sending an SMS with your ID to 32810. You can also visit the IEC's website at www.election.org.za for more information.

Besides the election, this semester is absolutely jam-packed with festivals, activities and events which involve our entire community. In March, we all receive a decent dose of culture with the annual Woordfees. We can also look forward to the annual Harvest Festival Parade and a variety of wonderful events that will take place on wine farms around our towns. Die eerste semester is ook baie besig op plaaslike regeringsvlak. Aan die einde van Januarie dien die aanpassingsbegroting voor die Raad. Dit is 'n jaarlikse proses wat volgens wet uitgevoer moet om voorsiening te maak in die begroting vir veral addisionele befondsing wat ons ontvang vanaf die nasionale en/of provinsiale regering vir projekte. Aanpassings kan ook gemaak word in geprojekeerde inkomstes en uitgawes wat moontlik verander het.

In Maart sal die volle en nuwe konsepbegroting vir die 2019/2020 finansiële jaar voor die Raad dien. Die konsep sal dan uitgaan vir openbare deelname en die Geïntegreerde Ontwikkelingsplanproses. Dit is waar u die geleentheid kry om as inwoner insette te lewer en sê op watter projekte die begroting moet fokus. U deelname is uiters belangrik omdat dit uiteindelik 'n begroting is wat aan u behoeftes moet voorsien. Na die openbare deelname proses sal 'n finale begroting voor die Raad dien wat dan weer op 1 Julie 2019 in werking sal tree.

Daar is ook 'n paar belangrike projekte wat deur die loop van die eerste semester geloods gaan word. Ek is baie opgewonde oor hierdie projekte, want dit sal verseker dat dienslewering verbeter in die gemeenskap. Ons gaan onder andere die satelliet brandweerstasie in Klapmuts open asook die nuwe Operasionele Kamer vir Veiligheid en Sekuriteit en die Thusong gemeenskapsaal in Klapmuts. Soos die reëlins gefinaliseer word, sal die datums bekend gemaak word. Kyk gerus op ons webblad asook op die Munisipaliteit se Facebook en Twitter blaaie vir besonderhede.

Ons is vasbeslote om alle agterstallige titelaktes te finaliseer en gaan voort hiermee so gou ons kan. The first semester is also very busy at local government level. At the end of January, the adjustment budget serves before council. It is an annual process that must be performed to make provisions in the budget, especially for additional funding received from national and/or provincial government for projects. Adjustments can also be made in the projected income and losses.

In March, the new and complete draft budget for the 2019/2020 financial year will serve before council. The draft will then go out for public participation and the Integrated Development Plan process. This is where you get the opportunity to provide feedback and to tell us which programmes to focus on. Your participation is extremely important. In the end, it is a budget that must look after your needs. Following the completion of the public participation process, a final budget will serve before council and will be implemented on 1 July 2019.

There are several important projects that will be officially launched during the course of the first semester. I am very excited about these projects because it will ensure better service delivery to the community. Amongst others, we will be opening the satellite fire station in Klapmuts, the Operational Room for Safety and Security and the Thusong Community Hall in Klapmuts. As the details for the events are finalised, the dates will be announced. Please have a look on our webpage and keep an eye on our Facebook and Twitter pages for more details.

We are determined to finalise all the outstanding title deeds and we are continuing with this as quickly as possible. Giving title deeds to residents is something that is close to my heart because it helps to empower people. It also provides safety, stability and opportunity to residents who for years could not enjoy the benefits and advantages of owning a property. What a privilege it is to wipe out these disadvantages!

As promised, we took a critical look at law enforcement and the organogram was improved to include the appointment of a senior manager that is highly knowledgeable and experienced. It is my great pleasure to welcome Mr Charl Kitching as the new head of Safety and Security. Mr Kitching will help us

Ons is nie verseker van goeie winterreën nie, en tot ons damme meer as 80% vol is, moet ons versigtig werk. Ek is saam met u bly dat daar weer 'n bietjie water na ons tuine kan gaan, want ek is passievol oor 'n mooi tuin, maar ons moet steeds waterwys dink en eerder fokus op meer geharde, inheemse plante wat nie so baie water nodig het nie. Hou ook asseblief aan met die besparingsmaatreëls wat die afgelope jaar 'n lewenswyse geword het vir baie van ons.

He was part of the City of Cape Town team for years and played an important role in safety and security for the city. Since December, we have been on level 2 water restrictions. The cooperation of our residents, the Municipality's good planning and the rain we received during the winter, has given us much needed relief. The drought is however not over because our dams are still under pressure. I want to encourage you to please save water and to use it responsibly. We are not guaranteed of good winter rains and our dams are not yet 80% full. We must take care of our resources.
