Die opkomende entrepreneurs wat ek tydens die geleentheid ontmoet het is net so opgewonde vir die ondersteuning en leiding wat aan hulle gebied word en die besigheidsmoontlikhede wat die perseel vir hulle bied. Ek is werklik beïndruk met veral die jongmense van regoor ons gemeenskap wat werk skep vir hulself deur praktiese vaardighede, maar ook deur die gebruik van moderne tegnologie. Daarom het ek onlangs 'n bietjie aandag gegee aan die besigheidsmense van Cloeteville. Dit is so 'n voorreg om te sit en luister na die stories van die besigheidseienaars en families wat al vir generasies in die omgewing bly. Dit is mense wat 'n werklike passie vir hul gemeenskap het en deur hul besigheidsbelange hul hele omgewing wil help verbeter en vorentoe neem.

Ek het ook die besigheidsvroue van Cloeteville genooi vir 'n oggendgeleentheid. Hierdie groep dinamiese vroue, het almal 'n ongelooflike passie vir hul gemeenskap en is almal betrokke by hul eie besighede. Hul is ambisieus, passievol en werk in verskeie ambagte wat strek van spyseniering tot elektronika. entrepreneurs manned their own booths and was on hand to give advice, answer questions and give guidance to especially young people who want to start their own businesses. I am so pleasantly surprised by the incredible entrepreneurs who are already operating in the greater Stellenbosch region. We truly have some wonderful talent from across our entire region.

We recently launched another initiative to empower entrepreneurs. In previous newsletters I mention that Ranyaka Community Trust won the contract to transform the old Victoria Street Clinic into an economic hub. Ranyaka hosted an introduction evening to show the community what they are planning for this space, to ask the community for inputs in their plans and to draw potential investors. I must say, I am very impressed with the initiative and the plans they have. The new entrepreneurs I met at the event are equally excited for the support and guidance that they are getting as well as the business opportunities that this space will provide them with. I am so impressed by the young people, coming from all over our community who are creating employment for themselves by applying practical skills but also using modern technology. A simple device like a smart phone opens a whole new world for them!

The Business Forum

In recent months I met with existing business representatives. Even our more established business men and women are full of wonderful ideas and initiatives about how to build and empower their communities. Throughout the year we make time to meet and talk with the various business groups in town and to listen to how we can help them as part of the Business Forum.

That is why I recently gave some attention to the business people in Cloeteville. It is such a privilege to sit and listen to the stories of business owners and families who have been living in the area for generations. It is people with a true passion for their community and want to improve their community and take them forward by using their business interests.

I also invited the women of Cloeteville for a morning event. This group of dynamic women all have an incredible passion for their community and they are all involved in their own businesses. They are ambitious, passionate and work in various fields ranging from catering to electronics.

This is only the first step to engage with women from the broader Stellenbosch region and to help and empower them so that women have access to equal opportunities.

Highlights for 2019

When one comes to the end of the year, it is only right that we think back about everything that happened during 2019. I am incredibly proud of everything we have achieved. It truly was a year filled with highlights! We have worked very hard the past three years to get the corner stones and foundation in place on which we can build. Although there is still much to be done, we managed some very special achievements. I recall some of my favourite projects.

There will always be challenges with regards to housing. Despite these challenges we made great progress with the moving of our old housing list the new Housing Demand

Behuisingsaanvraagdatabase. Met die proses word al die inligting op die database gekontroleer en opgedateer deur samewerking en konsultasie met die inwoners. As deel van die proses het ons ook 'n behuisingstoepassing geloods wat dit vir inwoners makliker maak om op die behuisingsdatabase te registreer.

Daarmee saam het ons ook 'n groot aantal titelaktes oorhandig. Eienaarskap is vir my baie belangrik dit sekuriteit bied aan inwoners wat vir die heel eerste keer in hul lewens hul eiendom besit. Ons het nog 'n finale geleentheid vir 2019 gehou op 21 November, waar ons nog 132 titel aktes aan inwoners oorhandig het. Hierdie aktes is deel van 'n historiese agterstand waaraan ons hard werk om uit te wis. Met die hulp van die Free Market Foundation se Kaya Lam Stigting en die Reinet Stigting, was dit my voorreg om aan hierdie inwoners, reg voor Kersfees die grootste geskenk denkbaar te oorhandig, eienaarskap van hul huis!

Verskeie behuisingsprojekte is ook aan die gang. In Idasvallei is vir die eerste keer in meer as 30 jaar gebou. Soekmekaar in Cloeteville se groot projek is reeds toegeken aan die beste tender. Die O Zone in Kayamandi het 'n aanvang geneem. Die hagglike toestande in Mandela City informele gebied is omskep in baie oulike tydelike eenhede. Die Longlands projek wat al sedert 2009 sloer, se finale kontrakte om dit moontlik te maak, is ook uiteindelik geteken.

Ek dink ook terug aan ons programme en die vaardigheidsprogram.

Die Gee Verantwoordelik veldtog wat hawelose probeer help op 'n meer volhoubare wyse loop nog sterk en tot op datum is daar meer as 7000 koepons verkoop en meer as 2800 ingeruil vir dienste!

Klapmuts het 'n nuwe satelliet-brandweerstasie en pragtige moderne veeldoelige gemeenskapsentrum ryker geraak.

Franschhoek se spasie vir informele handelaars is uiteindelik voltooi asook die een in Idasvallei en die spasies word reeds gebruik.

Ons nuwe personeel organogram is geïmplementeer. Ons brandweerwa met 'n lang leer waaroor ons nooddienste droom sedert 2009 is aangekoop en afgelewer.

Dit is maar van die enkele hoogtepunte, maar ek kan u verseker daar is nog blaaie vol! Dit beteken egter nie dat die werk nou klaar is nie, daar lê nog baie harde werk voor, maar ek is baie tevrede dat ons mooi op pad is na 'n Munisipaliteit van uitnemendheid.

16 Dae van Aktiwisme

Die jaarlikse veldtog vir 16 Dae van Aktiwisme vir Geen Geweld teen Vroue en Kinders skop op 25 November weer af en duur tot 10 Desember. Die gebeure van die afgelope jaar het by ons almal 'n groter bewussyn gekweek oor die belang van hierdie veldtog. Die afgelope jaar was koerante vol van 'n ongekende aantal gruweldade teen vroue en kinders. Wat my hart breek is dat in so baie gevalle die aanvaller aan die slagoffer bekend was.

Ons moet aanhou praat oor die voorkoming van geweld teen veral vroue en kinders. Ons moet eerlike praat met mekaar oor hoekom dit gebeur en ons moet bewus wees van die tekens van

Database. With this process all the information on the database is being verified and updated in cooperation and consultation with the residents. As part of this process we have also launched a housing app that makes it easier for residents to register on the housing database.

We also managed to transfer a large number of title deeds. Ownership is very important because it provides security to residents who own their homes for the very first time in their lives. We have another final event for 2019 which took place on 21 November where we handed over another 132 title deeds. These deeds form part of a historical backlog that we are making effort to clear up. With the assistance of the Free Market Foundation's Kaya Lam project and the Reinet Foundation it was my privilege to give these residents the greatest gift just in time for Christmas, the ownership of their home!

Various housing projects are also underway. In Ida's Valley we are busy with the first project for more than 30 years and the tender for the project in Soekmekaar in Cloeteville have already been awarded. The project in Zone O in Kayamandi has started and the horrible circumstances of residents in Mandela City informal settlement has been transformed by nice temporary structures. The final contracts have been signed in the Longlands project that has been coming since 2009.

I also remember our various programs and skills development initiatives.

The Give Responsibly campaign that helps homeless people on a more sustainable basis is still going strong and to date have sold more than 7000 coupons. More than 2800 has been traded in for services.

Klapmuts received a brand new satellite fire station and a beautiful multi-purpose centre.

Franschhoek's informal trading spaces have been completed as well as the one in Ida's Valley and it is already being used. We have implemented a new organogram. Our new fire truck with its hydraulic ladder platform that our emergency services has been dreaming about since 2009 also arrived.

This is only some of the highlights, but I can assure you there are still pages more! This does not mean that our work is done. There is still a lot of hard work ahead and I am very satisfied that our Municipality is on its way to excellence.

16 Days of Activism

The annual campaign for 16 Days of Activism against Violence against Women and Children starts on 25 November and continues until 10 December. The events of the past year created great awareness with us all about how relevant this campaign still is. The past year our newspapers were filled with an overwhelming number of stories about horrible acts committed against women and children. We must continue to talk about the prevention of violence against especially women and children. We must be honest with one another about why it happens and we must be aware of the signs of abuse where women and children are victims.
