August is Women's Month. As South Africans we commemorate the role women played in the struggle against apartheid, but we also focus on the

As 'n prokureur en later 'n landdros, het ek baie ervaring met mishandelde vrouens en kinders. Daar is nie genoeg woorde om vir u te laat verstaan wat 'n afgrylike misdaad die mishandeling van vroue en kinders is nie. Die stories wat ek gehoor het, hou my tot vandag toe nog wakker. Geweld en mishandeling van vroue en kinders is nie iets wat beperk is tot sosio-ekonomiese omstandighede nie. Jy kry dit orals, in ryk en arm huise, die slagoffers is oud en jonk, en selfs die oortreders word in elke plek in ons samelewing gevind, baie keer in plekke waar jy dit soms die minste verwag. En daarom word daar steeds nie baie hieroor gepraat nie.

Daar is nie 'n maklike of eenvoudige oplossing hiervoor nie. Dit is 'n probleem wat uit meer as een hoek aangespreek moet word en as gemeenskap het ons almal 'n rol te speel. Ons moet meer doen as net fokus op die beskerming van slagoffers van geweld, en ons moet ook fokus oor hoe om geslagsgebaseerde geweld te voorkom. Ernstige introspeksie is nodig om te sien wat fout is met ons as 'n samelewing, en hoekom dit gebeur. Waar leer ons kinders sulke gedrag aan? Wat doen ons as volwassenes dat die volgende generasie dink dit is aanvaarbaar om mense so te behandel. As ouers, grootouers, ooms, tantes en versorgers is dit ons verantwoordelikheid om seuns te leer hoe om vroue en kinders met respek te behandel van kleins af. Ons moet ook meer doen om meisies selfrespek te leer en nie hulle waarde te koppel aan dit wat in vandag se popkultuur uitbeeld word nie.

vulnerability of women and children in the South African community. Our news headlines are still dominated by stories of women and children who are abused or killed. Even though there is an international focus on women's rights, gender based violence in South Africa remains a great challenge. As a lawyer and later a magistrate, I have a lot of experience in working with abused women and children. There are not enough words to make you understand what a horrific crime the abuse of women and children is. The stories that I heard still keeps me awake at night. Violence and abuse of women and children is not something that is limited to socio-economic circumstances. You find it everywhere, in rich and poor homes, the victims are young and old and even the perpetrators are found in all walks of life, often times in places where you least expect it. And that is why we still don't talk enough about this.

Our only solution as a society is that we have to change our approach to gender-based violence. We must not only focus on protecting and helping the victims of these horrendous crimes. Instead, we should also focus on how to PREVENT gender-based violence. We need to do some serious introspection about why this is happening and what is wrong with us as a society that it happens so frequently. What is it that we are teaching our children that turns them into abusive adults? What example are we setting if our children grow up to be abusers, rapists and murderers of women and children? As mothers, fathers and carers of children we have a responsibility to teach every boy child how to treat women and children from the day they are born. We also have to teach our girl children to respect themselves, to value themselves and not to determine their value by the images and messages from popular culture.
