Liewe Inwoners,

 *Ek staan na soveel jare steeds in absolute verwondering oor die natuur. Nadat ons deur 'n uitmergelende somer is, was ek amper moedeloos omdat al ons tuinry dor en feitlik dood was. Na ons lekker eerste reën is alles egter weer groen en mooi, so amper asof dit nooit so droog was nie. Ongelukkig het ons damme nog nie eintlik water gekry nie en daar lê nog 'n opdraande stryd voor tensy dit baie gaan reën.*

Verkeersdepartement

Ons het aan die einde van verlede jaar, 'n groot verbetering ervaar in wagtye by ons verkeersdepartement. Inwoners het my egter die afgelope tyd laat weet dat die rye weer baie lank geraak het en dat inwoners vir ure kan wag. Daarom het ek met al die betrokke rolspelers gepraat oor die nodige oplossings om diens by die verkeersafdeling weer te verbeter. Ek hoop om binnekort 'n volhoubare langtermyn oplossing in plek te stel om dit aan te spreek.

Ek wil inwoners ook daaraan herinner om 'n nota te maak van u motor- en bestuurderslisensies se vervaldatum. Die provinsiale stelsel wat die kennisgewings hiervoor uitstuur, ervaar steeds probleme en ons vind dikwels dat inwoners nie betyds, of glad nie in kennis gestel word dat hul lisensies amper verval nie. Maak seker u weet wanneer u die onderskeie lisensies moet hernu, en doen dit betyds. Voertuiglisensies moet jaarliks hernu word, terwyl bestuurderlisensies elke 5 jaar hernu moet word.

Dear Residents,

 *After so many years I still stand in absolute wonder of nature. Following our exhausting summer, I almost lost hope because all our gardens have dried up and was almost dead. After our first good rains, everything is green and beautiful again, almost as if there is no drought at all. Unfortunately, our dams have not received sufficient water yet and there is still an uphill battle ahead unless we receive a lot of rain.*

Traffic Department

At the end of last year, we experienced a significant improvement in our waiting times at the traffic department. Residents have however informed me that recently the queues are getting longer and longer and that residents can often be left waiting for hours. That is why I have spoken with all the role-players involved about finding and implementing the necessary solutions to again improve services at the traffic department. I hope to implement a sustainable long-term solution soon to address this.

I also want to remind residents to please make a note about when your vehicle or driver's license expires. The provincial system issuing notices is still experiencing problems and we often find that residents are not informed timeously, or not at all, of when their licences expire. Please make sure you know when your licenses must be renewed and do it on time. Vehicle licenses must be renewed annually and driver's licenses must be renewed every 5 years.

Die Nieuwe Molen

Reg deur my loopbaan is daar gebeure en geleenthede waarvan ek deel was wat vir altyd by my sal bly. Ek was onlangs weer bevoorreg om deel te wees van so 'n uiters spesiale geleentheid met die amptelike onthulling van die Meulwiel op Meulplein. As u gereeld deur die middel van Stellenbosch ry sal u sien dat die ikoniese Meulwiel weer terug is in die hartjie van die dorp. Die Nieuwe Molen Meulwiel, soos dit amptelik bekendstaan, is 'n deel van Stellenbosch se geskiedenis wat terug dateer uit die 19de eeu. Die wiel wat langs die Rhyense Kerk gestaan het tot 1963, is in veilige bewaring gehou deur Wilgenhof Manskoshuis. Die vorige raad het die projek begin om die geskiedkundige ikoon van Stellenbosch weer te hervestig so na as moontlik aan sy oorspronklike huis. Die internasionaal bekende plaaslike landskapkunsenaar, Mnr Strijdom van der Merwe het die ontwerp en uitleg van die projek gedoen.

Hierdie wiel gaan beslis 'n internasionale kenteken en simbool word van ons area. Ek is so bly oor die nuwe tuiste van die wiel en die bewaring van 'n unieke deel van ons geskiedenis, want dit is nie altyd maklik om 'n balans te hou tussen ons unieke historiese omgewing en moderne vooruitgang nie. Die terugkeer van die waterwiel is egter 'n wonderlike voorbeeld van hoe ons kuns, kultuur en geskiedenis kan bewaar. Ek wil graag baie dankie sê vir die Stellenbosch Kunsvereniging en al die ander rolspelers wat seker gemaak het dat hierdie projek voltooi word. The Nieuwe Molen

Throughout my career there have been events that I was part of that will always stay with me. Recently, I was again privileged to be part of such a very special event with the official reveal of the Mill Wheel on Mill Square. If you often drive through Stellenbosch, you will see that the iconic Mill Wheel has been returned to the heart of town. The Nieuwe Molen Mill, as it is officially known, is part of Stellenbosch's history that dates back to the 19th century. The wheel, which was located next to the Rhenish Church until 1963, was safely kept by the Wilgenhof Men's Residence. The previous Council started the project to return the wheel as close as possible to its original home. The internationally renowned local landscape artist, Mr Strijdom van der Merwe, was responsible for the design of the project.

This wheel will definitely become an international token and symbol for our area. I am so happy about the new home for the mill and the preservation of a unique part of our history, because it is not always easy to find a balance between our unique historical surrounds and modern progress. The return of the wheel is however a wonderful example of we can preserve art, history and culture. I want to thank the Stellenbosch Art Association and all the other stakeholders who ensured this project's success. It is a great privilege for me to be part of Stellenbosch's history in this unique way.

Ida's Valley Market

To create opportunities for residents is an absolute priority for me. As a municipality, our main purpose is to deliver the best services, but when this is in place, it creates opportunities for economic growth, which in turns creates opportunities for residents. From this flows the opportunity to encourage entrepreneurship in our communities by building informal trading spaces for informal traders.

The Ida's Valley Market at the entrance of Ida's Valley is an example of this. It is a wonderful space which focuses on drawing

Die skenkings wat ons verlede jaar ontvang het, het werklik baie 'n groot verskil gemaak aan die lewens van inwoners in nood. Wat wel verander het, is ons inwoners se wonderlike samewerking. Ons data wys hoe amper al ons inwoners regtig saamwerk en water spaar net waar hul kan. Baie dankie, ons is trots op u en waardeer u opofferings. Daar moet nog baie water val voor die damvlakke in Boland en Overbergstreek weer merkwaardig sal styg. Daarom doen ek 'n ernstige beroep op inwoners om nie te laat slap lê nie, en aan te hou water spaar.

A total of four informal markets will be built across the Municipality. The building work at the Kayamandi market space will be done by July 2018 and in September the spaces at Cloeteville and Franschhoek will be completed. The project will make a total of 67 stalls available to upcoming entrepreneurs from across our municipal area.

I want to encourage our residents to visit these markets and to support them. I am sure you will enjoy it as much as I have.

Donations

Over the past few weeks we have been blessed with wonderful rainy days. The rain is however accompanied with some challenges and adversely affect residents in our informal settlements. We already had a few incidences where residents had to be temporarily relocated because of the severe weather. We also had several serious fires in informal areas, in which some residents lost everything. Residents in informal settlements are the most affected by our winter weather. Drought

As you know, the end of the drought is not yet in sight. Along with other affected municipalities we remain on level 6B water restrictions. I recently read in our local papers that there are residents who question the water restrictions after the rains and others who speculate that the water situation is not that serious. Other people allege that the municipality tries to unnecessarily increase rates. I can assure you that the water situation is still as serious as it was. What has changed is the amazing cooperation of our residents. Our data shows how almost all residents are cooperating and saving water wherever possible. A lot of rain is still needed before the dam levels will rise significantly in the Boland and Overberg regions. That is why I urge all our residents not to let up with their water saving efforts, but to keep on saving water.
